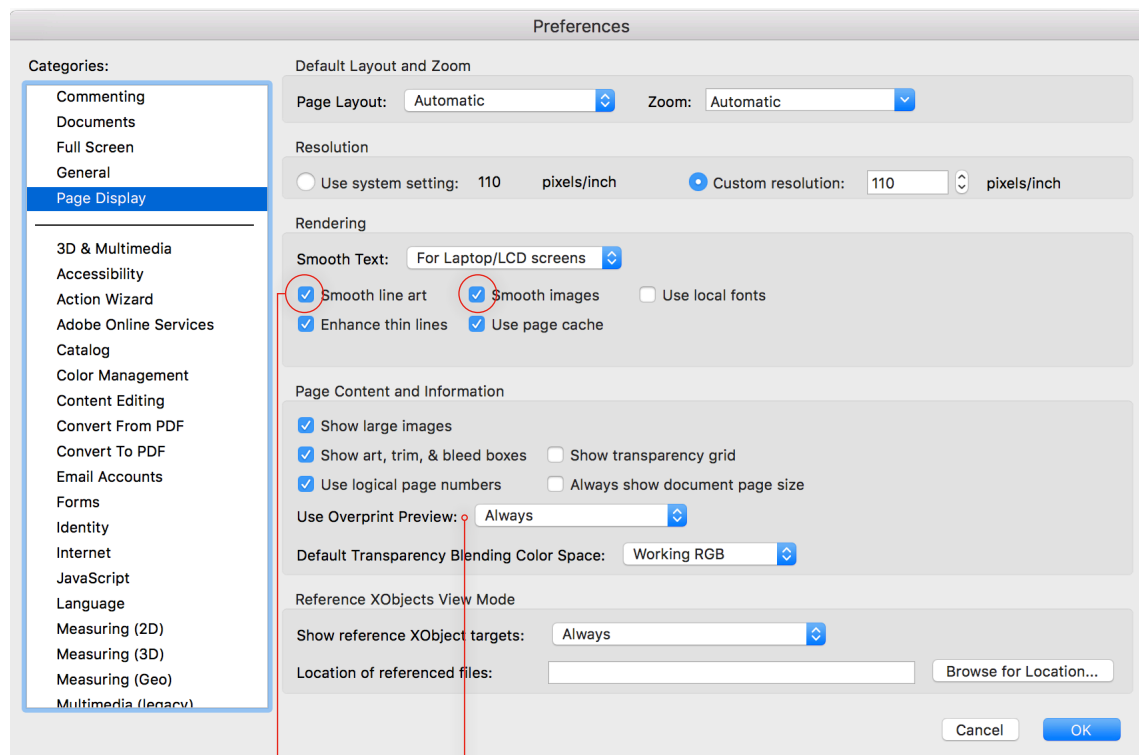


Using Overprint Preview when Soft-Proofing in Acrobat

When viewing PDFs in Adobe Acrobat, make sure you have Overprint Preview turned on. This will give you a more accurate display of how your PDF will look when printed.

Turn on Overprint Preview

Choose Preferences > Page Display and choose **Always** from the Use Overprint Preview pop-up menu



Choose **Always** from the Use Overprint Preview pop-up menu

Smooth line art and **Smooth images**: Line art and images will appear sharper having these two settings checked, but may introduce thin white lines, If you uncheck these two settings and the thin white lines disappear, then it's just a screen display issue.
