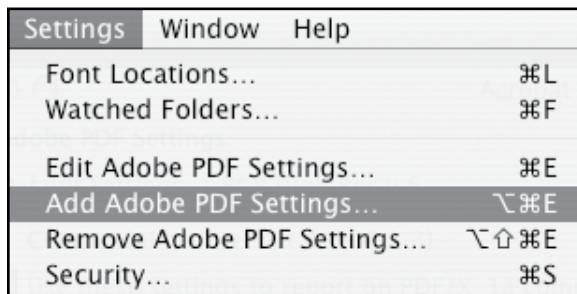

## Acrobat Distiller 9 Adobe PDF Settings

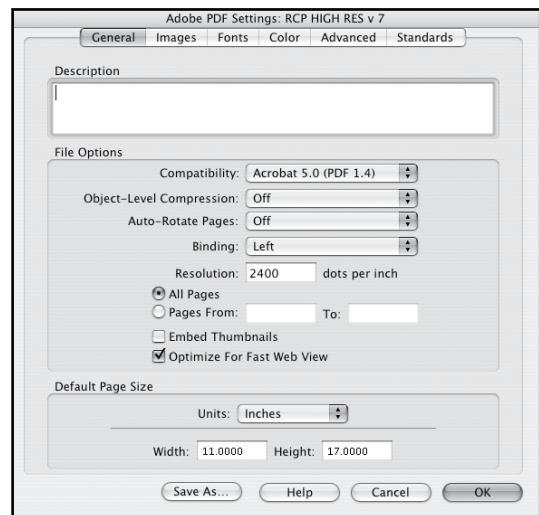
These are the settings that have proven successful for distilling PostScript files using Acrobat 9 here at Ripon Printers. In some instances even using these settings may not create a PDF file that processes flawlessly. It is crucial that you check the PDF file for any potential printing problems. Here at Ripon Printers we use PDF preflighting tools to check the PDF file for potential problems. We recommend that our customers use Enfocus PitStop to check the file. Please contact Jason Hauman, our customer education specialist, for a set of PitStop profiles that you can use for checking your files.

### I. CREATING PDF SETTINGS



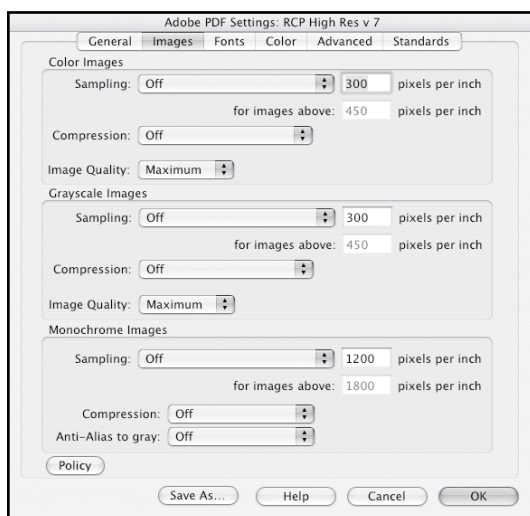
To create a new set of Adobe PDF Settings choose **Settings/Add Adobe PDF Settings**. The following screen shots will show you the settings that you need to make in each tab of Acrobat Distiller.

### 2. GENERAL



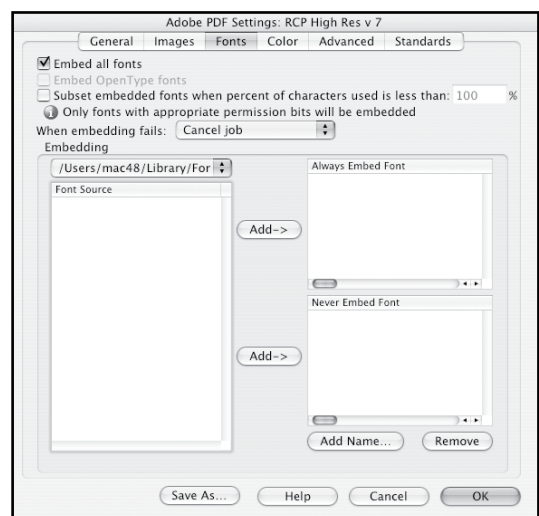
These are the settings that should be selected under the General tab.

### 3. IMAGES



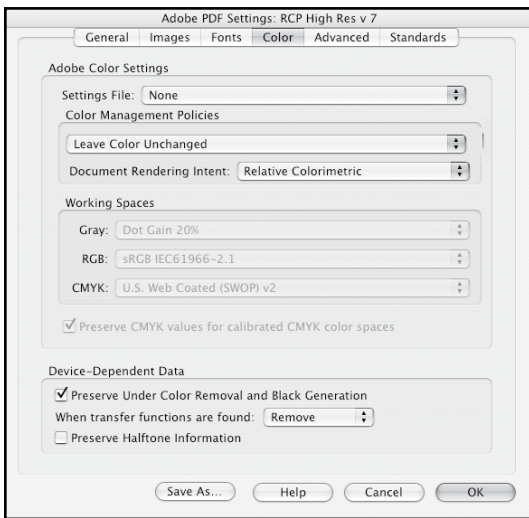
These are the settings that should be chosen under the Images tab.

### 4. FONTS



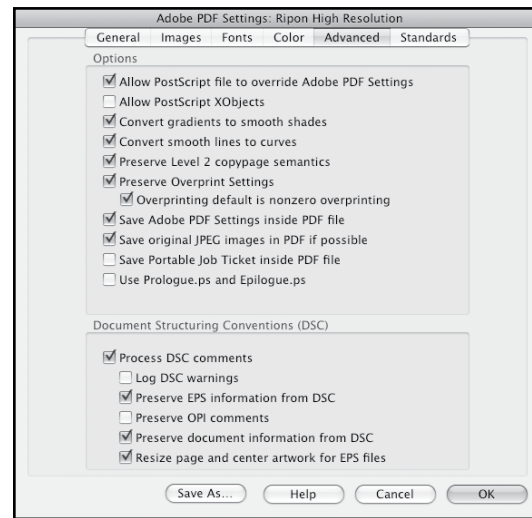
These are the settings that should be applied under the Fonts tab.

## 5. COLOR



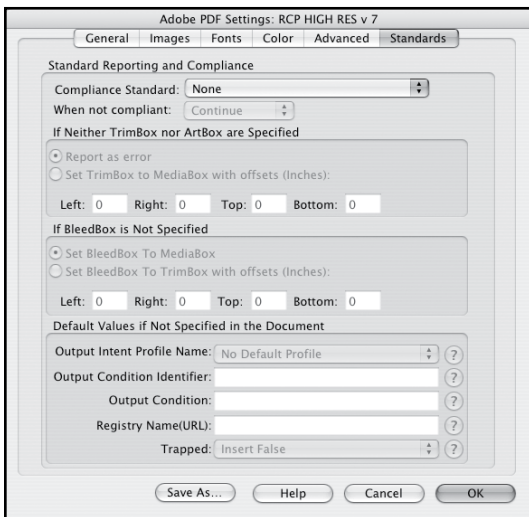
These are the settings that should be set under the Colors tab.

## 6. ADVANCED



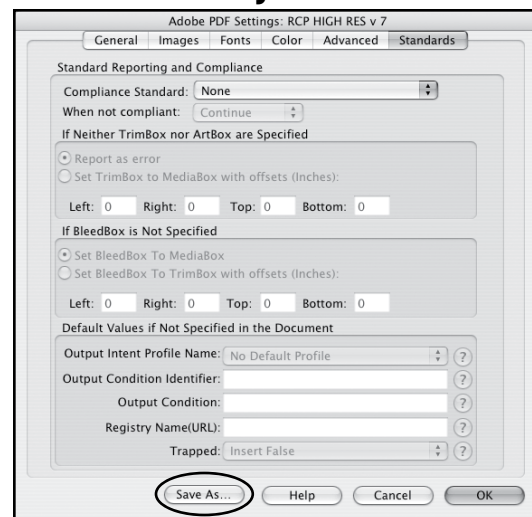
These are the settings that should be selected under the Advanced tab.
